The village of Svirstroy is located on the left bank of the Svir River. It arose during the construction of the Nizhne-Svirsky hydroelectric complex, which was directly connected with the history of the whole country.

Vytegra - the district center of the Vologda region. The name of the city has been known since 1710, when Peter the Great ordered the creation of the Vyanga pier here, the name was given by the Vytegra river, into which the Vyang-stream flowed. And the name of the river, quite likely, is taken from the languages of the peoples that have long inhabited these places: Veps, Finns, Karelians, Sami. The river flowing from Lake Matko began to be called the "lake river", that is, Vytegra.

**DAY 4**      23.06.2024, Sunday      Cherepovets

**Cherepovets**

Cherepovets is the largest city in the Vologda Oblast, a large industrial center. It is located on the banks of the Sheksna River, the channel of which was dissolved in the waters of the Rybinsk Reservoir. People settled here in the 2nd millennium BC. Archaeologists note that in the 9th century the whole tribe lived in these places, later mixed with the Slavs.

Yaroslavl is the unofficial capital of the Golden Ring of Russia and the oldest city on the Volga with a history of more than 1000 years. Many attractions are a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The city is famous for examples of ancient Russian architecture, magnificent landscapes of the Volga and unique museums. The famous Russian poet N. A. Nekrasov spent his childhood in Yaroslavl. Today Yaroslavl is a large industrial center.
