Kostroma is an ancient city in Central Russia on the Volga, included in the Golden Ring route. According to the legend, it was in the Kostroma lands where the heroine of Russian fairy tales was born - the Snow Maiden. One of the most significant sights of Kostroma is the Ipatiev Monastery, where on March 14, 1613 the Romanov dynasty was elected by Zemsky Cathedral to rule the kingdom.

The Jewel of the Volga, the city of Plyos, since 1410 it has been situated on the high slopes of the right bank, which rises here by almost 80 meters. The river in these places for 20 km has a straight channel - "plyos", and therefore the fortress got its name.
