Shaman Rock on Cape Burkhan is one of the nine shrines of Asia and is the only one located on the territory of Russia. Then we will take the hovercraft "Biryusa" to Maly Khuzhir settlement, where we will get acquainted with Buryat customs and national cuisine in the ethnocomplex "Buryat Village".

The length of the island is 2,9 km, and the width is 0,6 km. It is the largest island in the strait between Olkhon Island and the mainland. About a hundred herring gulls nest on the Ogoy Island.
