




GORITSY

Today, after passing through the Volga-Baltic Canal, our ship will stop in the village of Goritsy, surrounded by forests of the Vologda region. This land is famous for its monasteries, which history is closely connected with the history of Russia.



UGLICH

A little ancient town Uglich with a brightly coloured architecture is the gem of Russia's Golden Ring! Its Kremlin and the Church of St. Dmitry are particularly famous – the church's fascinating history is tied to the life and death of Ivan the Terrible's son.



↑ KIZHI

Set foot on this unique island in the Onega Lake and begin your journey in the open-air museum of wooden architecture. The Architectural Ensemble of the Kizhi Pogost is a UNESCO World Heritagelisted site. The tour involves inspection of the Kizhi architectural ensemble including the chapel of the Archangel Michael and the church of the Resurrection of Lazarus.

MANDROGUI

A traditional Russian village with typical wooden houses, numerous crafts exhibitions and a peaceful scenery with a picturesque landscape.



VALAAM

An exciting excursion to the Central homestead of the Transfiguration Valaam monastery awaits you. A special place during the tour is given to visiting the main active cathedral of the monastery – the majestic Transfiguration Cathedral, where the relics of Venerable Sergius and Herman of Valaam Wonderworkers rest.



ST. PETERSBURG



YAROSLAVL

Explore a unique beauty of the interior of the Church of Elijah the Prophet, lavishly decorated with elegant mural painting, sophisticated woodcarving of the gilded iconostasis.





↑ PLYOS

Take a walk through the landscapes that inspired iconic painter Isaac Levitan in Plyos, a medieval merchant town brimming with charm. It's a favourite holiday spot for Russia's elite, with beautifully-restored architecture lining peaceful streets.





↑ NIZHNY NOVGOROD

The city just recently celebrated its 800-year anniversary and during your stay you can get acquainted with its rich history and ancient architecture. The main attraction is the Kremlin that was built at the beginning of the 16th century as a military fortress. The city is a large industrial, cultural and transport center of the Middle Volga.



↑ VOLGOGRAD

Get acquainted with the main tourist attractions of Volgograd, see a central promenade, an obelisk in the Square of Fallen Fighters, the Lenin Square. The memorial complex «To the Heroes of Stalingrad Battle» on the Mamaev Mound will allow you to see the noted Monument «Motherland Calls!» and the square of «Standing to the death!».

* KAZAN

The appearance of the capital of the Republic of Tatarstan is determined by a mixture of Russian and eastern colors. For more than four centuries, Kazan has been surrounded by the white walls of the Kremlin, which is now a UNESCO monument. You will see such attractions as the Old Tatar settlement, the Marjani Mosque, the famous G. Kamal theatre and more than 100 years-old Kazan University.

ASTRAKHAN

Visit the Kremlin (the Assumption and the St. Nicholas Cathedrals), the Swan Lake, the Lenin Square, the historic center of the city and the fish market as well. Enjoy a wonderful view of the city from the «new» bridge across the Volga, one of the longest in Europe.
